

BMBA Board Meeting
March 26, 2007

Liz Martin reported that the newsletter is being printed and she will distribute about 200 copies.

There was a discussion about membership – Kristin is contacting a number of businesses about joining our association.

Tony noted that the Irem Temple Country Club will undergo a five + million dollar building project with a new golf center and clubhouse.

Representatives from the Dallas School District presented a slide presentation showing the poor condition of the Dallas Elementary School and the Dallas Senior High School. It is estimated that construction of a new high school would cost in the vicinity of 38 million dollars. It was decided that this presentation be scheduled for a general membership meeting in the fall.

There was a discussion about the Theatre Project and fund raising. The County has indicated that it will provide a \$250,000 matching grant towards renovation. It was moved and carried that the BMBA will provide the first contribution to the Theatre Project in the amount of \$ 2500. It was also decided that we would have a presentation about the Theatre Project at a fall membership meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
